

# ANCIENT ERAS Lower School Topic Summer Term 2019

This Topic will look at the achievements of the Ancient Egyptian Civilisation and the changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. It will cover chronology, giving an overview of when these two periods of history occurred. The children will gain an understanding of how we know about the past by using a range of sources. Scientific enquiry skills will be developed during the 'The Nappy Challenge' Unit and the effect and use of forces and magnets will be investigated. The children will have the opportunity to become a 'Mummy' in a group challenge and participate in 'Stone Age' themed tasks.



**Science** – Forces and Magnets. 'The Nappy Challenge' (Scientific Enquiry)

**History** – Ancient Egypt Study focussing on their achievements as an Ancient Civilisation and British History Study covering the changes from Early Man to the Iron Age Culture.

**Art** – Designing cartouches and using hieroglyphs as decoration. Using charcoal and chalk to create cave paintings.

**Design and Technology** – Designing, creating and evaluating Egyptian Masks and model tombs.

**RE** – 'What do Old Testament stories teach us about God? What do different religions teach us about Creation?'

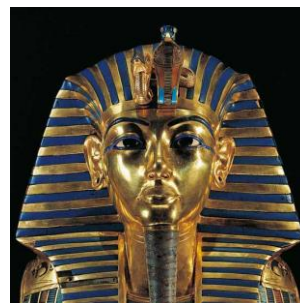
