Cyber Bullying (the use of any technology) has also been covered by Mrs Griffiths through the Kidsafe Programme and by Jeff Haslam (E Safety Adviser for the Local Authority) during our annual E Safety Training Day for pupils, parents, staff and governors.

All of this input is age appropriate, teaching the children how to keep themselves safe.
