Geography – Location of Rome in Europe, expansion of the Roman Empire. The impact of Roman Rule on British infrastructure and its modern day legacy.

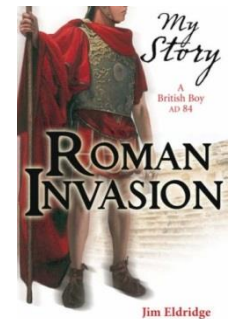
